




Introduction

Living Laudato Si - ELSiA's first European survey is designed to be a discovery tool for Catholic organizations to gain an understanding of all the Laudato Si'-inspired initiatives implemented from the publication of the encyclical to date across Europe.

It is intended as an **information tool** for all categories of respondents and for the survey designers and the results are meant to **highlight the contributions of the Catholics Church** to the **Care for Creation**.
